Challenge Fabric and rules will be available at guild meetings through April. Additional fabric may be purchased by calling or emailing Kay Wilton before the meeting.



that creativity for sale in her Etsy shops or in her family's Poynette, Wisconsin apple orchards shop during the fall apple season.

Kim is a huge fan of online quilt-a-longs. Participating in them has really helped hone her piecing skills and encouraged her to try things she never thought she would try.

In 2010, Kim dreamed up *Project QUILTING*, and since then hundreds of quilts have been created and thousands of dollars' worth of prizes have been awarded. She enjoys sharing her enthusiasm about creativity through teaching, lecturing, and blogging.


