About our Classes

We need your support to bring in these teachers. We hope that you will take a class (or two!) and the lectures/trunk show presentations are always free to our guild members. If you were to go see these teachers anywhere else you would pay at least \$20 to see a short lecture, usually much more than that. AQS classes run about \$80-\$88 for a full day class if you are an AQS member, or \$100 for non-members, PLUS any kit fees, or fabrics & supplies you may need to purchase. Our guild brings these teachers to you and we try to keep the cost as low as possible. If we could know that every single class would fill up, we could keep the costs lower. For any class, I would guess that you would learn SOMETHING, whether it's the new technique, a pattern you haven't tried, a new tip or tool, or even some little tidbit you didn't know about the teacher or your fellow quilters. Many teachers don't expect you to go out and purchase all new fabrics to take their class. They are happy that you could bring your own fabrics from your stash, even if it is only to learn the technique and not to make a whole big quilt. Remember that, each time classes are offered.


