Susan's mitering technique and built-in sashing will make this block much easier than traditional piecing, will produce accurate results, and will take any fear out of mitered corners. This technique may then be applied to any project involving mitered corners or borders. Quilting and finishing will be discussed.

Susan teaches with a camera and projector to show live demos on a screen. Everyone sees great details!

Susan's quilts have won awards at many International Quilt Festivals in Houston and AQS shows in Paducah. She has appeared on Craftsy, Simply Quilts, TheQuiltShow.com and other shows to share her mitering, Piping Hot Binding, and Piping Hot Curves techniques. Her work has appeared in Quilter's Newsletter magazine, the International Quilt Journal, American Quilter and several other major quilting magazines. She loves sharing tips for increasing accuracy and adding details to quilts.
