The PALS Quilt Show has been very successful because of the member participation, your participation. Here are some ways that you can be a part. We need your quilts. You may enter two quilts. The sizes are large, small, and miniature. We will have a judge. If that is a concern, please know that the quilts are totally anonymous. She will not critique the quilts and she will not give any feedback. You can purchase the required challenge fabric from Marilyn Suchecki and make a challenge quilt. Our theme is "Hearts, For the Love of Quilting". Another way to participate is sharing your "first quilt" for the bed turning. It can be the first quilt you made, or one that was the first quilt you received or purchased.

We've taken in so many quilting related things! WOW, great response! Keep them coming as the show will be here before you know it. Remember, fabric needs to be measured, marked and smoke free.

#### **Challenge Quilts**

Challenge fabric will be available at each meeting. The red batik is \$4.00 for a fat quarter. The rules are printed below and will be given with the fabric at time of purchase.

- 1. Size 20" X 20" -- Quilts outside this size will not qualify for judging
- 2. Must be 3 layers--- top, batting and backing. Also must be bound
- 3. Must be guilted by hand or machine
- 4. The challenge must be completed by one person
- 5. No names on the front of the quilt
- 6. Entry must have a registration form
- 7. Challenge fabric is provided at a cost of \$4.00 per fat quarter
- 8. Additional fabric may be purchased from the Challenge Chair
- 9. Entry must have a recognizable amount of the challenge fabric within the quilt design, not just the binding or backing
- 10. 2019 Challenge quilt must have at least <u>one</u> heart. It may be pieced, appliqued, or three dimensional.

## WHAT YOU KEED TO KNOW

- Only active members of PALS may enter quilts in the show.
- . PALS members may each enter TWO quilts for display.
- Entry forms are due on or before April 8, 2019 at the PALS general meeting. No late entries will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- All entry forms must be accompanied by a photo of the quilt for identification purposes. This does not need to be a professional photo (a home printer copy will work). Beginning in February, a member of the Quilt Show board will be available to take a photo for your entry if necessary. PHOTOS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.
- \* Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in the following categories:

Large (61" X 61" or larger) Small (up to 60" X 60") Miniature (up to 20" X 20") Guild Challenge (20" X 20")

There will be separate categories for:

Hand Quilted Long Arm Quilted Domestic Machine Quilted

Ribbons will also be given for Best in Show and Viewer's Choice. No monetary awards will be given.

- Quilts to be entered in the show will be accepted at the church ONLY at the following times.
   Wednesday, May 8, from 5 pm to 7 pm.
   Thursday, May 9, from 7:30 am to 9 am.
- Please fold all quilts backing side out, with lower right corner of the front turned back. We will demonstrate at meetings as the show nears.
- No quilts will be offered for sale at the show.
- PALS Quilt Guild and Fellowship Reformed Church are not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to any item shown at the show. Normal precautions will be taken to protect belongings at all times. The church will be securely locked when not in use. Quilt owners who desire insurance must provide it themselves.
- PALS Quilt Guild is not responsible for any quilt which is not picked up by 6:00 pm Saturday.
   May 11. No quilt will be released after the show without the claim tag received at drop-off. If your quilt will be picked up by someone else, that person MUST have the claim tag. NO EXCEPTIONS:


