Directions to Elks Park:

From US 31: Take exit 107 Pontaluna Rd, turn west onto Pontaluna Rd. Pontaluna will turn into Lake Harbor Rd. Elks Park will be on your left @ 5447 Lake Harbor Rd From Muskegon take Henry Street south to Porter Rd (corner by Pic 'n Pac), turn right, continue to Lake Harbor Rd, turn left, Elks Park will be on your right.

We will plan on playing Left Right Center!

Please bring six* (jelly roll type) strips – 2-1/2" x WOF in Red, White and Blue of your choice, separately packaged in Ziploc baggies.







You still have time to donate a quilt. We will be collecting quilts at the August Picnic. We will also be holding a Charity quilt sewing day which will be held on Saturday, September 28th at Abbi Mays Quilt shop from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Come and work on a quilt or drop off your finished ones.

This year we have six charities that will receive quilts coming up at our October guild meeting: Love Inc, Every Woman's Place, Women and Family Rescue Mission Muskegon, Catholic Charities of West Michigan, Muskegon Pregnancy Services and we are partnering with Fellowship Church to donate 16 quilts for One Day with God.

We have renewed the PALS Quilts of Valor group membership. If you want to become/renew your individual membership, we need \$5.00. We have made up some time-saving block kits for our QOV group projects. We've precut the fabric for you. You can get these blocks for \$2.00 each. The money collected from these blocks will be used to purchase backing fabric for our QOV quilts. We also have one kit made up for piecing.

The 2019 block drive is the Friendship Star. The block should be 12.5" x 12.5" unfinished (12" x 12" finished) using a white background. Please see the QOV page on our PALS website for fabric requirements. The blocks, collected throughout the year, will be pieced into quilts by PALS volunteers in late fall.


