#### January

Bring 2 of your favorite fat quarters to the meeting. One should be a contrast to the other. You WILL go back home with your own fat quarters (unless you CHOOSE to swap with a friend, but we won't be asking you to do that). Come and see what we have planned!

We will also be taking sign-ups for the Flurry quilt block swap. You can find the FREE pattern at <a href="https://www.unitednotions.com/fp\_flurry.pdf">www.unitednotions.com/fp\_flurry.pdf</a>

PLEASE NOTE: this pattern uses a panel for the cornerstones. You will need to figure out which fabrics you want in your 4 corners. We will have enough for the 2-1/2" sashing cornerstones from our swapping. The pattern also gives cutting requirements for 16 different blocks. I have read through the pattern and done the figuring for fabric requirement so you can make 16 blocks all alike, bring ALL 16 blocks to the swap. For this you will need 1-3/4 yards of QUALITY 100% cotton Christmas fabric for your gift blocks. For the ribbon portion, you will need 3/4 yard. And for the WHITE-ON-WHITE background, you will need 2-1/4 yards. Please read the Block Swap Guidelines included in this newsletter. They will also be available when you sign up for the block swap at the January or February meetings.

## "Flurry" by Kate Spain - Fabic Requirements

Quilt is 55" x 65" These requirements are for 16 blocks to swap.

Quilt Fabric Requirements  Gifts & Pieced Border:  1-3/4 yards  Ribbon:  ¾ yard  Background:  2-1/4 yards of white on white fabric  No off-whites or creams  Binding:  5/8 yard  Backing:  4 yards	Quilt Fabric Cutting  Gifts & Pieced Border:  8 - 4" x WOF strips(Width Of Fabric)
This pattern calls for "One Flurry Panel."	20 – 2-1/2" x 10-1/2"
I'm sure this is no longer available. This is	12 – 2-1/2" x 8-1/2"
Step 1 (A) in the pattern. You will need to decide	16 – 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"
which fabric(s) you want to use in the four corners.	40 – 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"
For 1(B) and 1(C) in the pattern, you will use the	15 – 2" x WOF strips
2-1/2" squares of swapped ribbon fabrics.	Set aside 11 strips
	Subcut 4 – 2" x 42-1/2"

**Binding:** 7 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips

For <u>each</u> block you swap, you must also include 8 - 2 - 1/2" x 2 - 1/2" squares of your <u>gifts fabric</u> to be used in the pieced border. Also include 1 - 2 - 1/2" x 2 - 1/2" square of your <u>ribbon fabric</u> for <u>each</u> block you swap. You will receive 16 of these back, but will only need 9 for the sashing cornerstones.

### "Flurry" by Kate Spain - Block Swap Guidelines

Sign up <u>BY</u> our February PALS membership meeting on 2/3/20.

Turn in your completed blocks to swap at our June PALS membership meeting on 6/1/20.

Bring your FINISHED Flurry Quilt for show and tell at our December PALS membership meeting/Christmas Gathering on 12/7/20.

Use only Quilt Shop QUALITY 100% cotton CHRISTMAS fabrics.

Background fabrics MUST BE white-on-white! NO creams or off-whites.

Accurate cutting and piecing is a must! Please make sure your cutting is accurate and your seams are a precise ¼". Please ask for help if you are unsure how to make your blocks correctly. No question is stupid to ask.

Measure all blocks – they must measure  $8-1/2" \times 10-1/2"$  when you bring them in to swap.

Do your BEST work. Think of this as the Golden Rule of Quilting: Give blocks to others that you would want others to give to you.

Don't procrastinate. Turn your blocks in on time. 15 other people are counting on you!

Encourage others. Share your progress on the PALS Facebook page. Bring your blocks to meetings before June for Show & Tell.

Most of all, <u>HAVE FUN!</u> Enjoy the process of this block swap and create a beautiful new quilt with other PALS quilters!
