All those who signed up to bring in the Flurry Christmas blocks in July, NOW'S the time! The swap will be done during the meeting so you will take home the beginnings of your newest quilt.

For bagging the Flurry Swap Blocks:

- \*Use Gallon Zip Bags, one for each block to be swapped, including your own. Put your name on the outside of each large bag.
- \*In a Snack bag, one for each block swapped, place: 8 matching 2 ½" squares of "gift" fabric and one 2 ½" square of "ribbon" fabric.
- \*These Large zip bags, will be turned in at the July meeting. If you have any questions, please ask Joy Lamphere or Jami Harwood.
