2021 Coopersville Farm Museum Quilt Exhibit

"Quilts & Their Stories" will be on exhibit this August and September at the Coopersville Farm Museum in downtown Coopersville, MI. The feature this year is the "Medallion" quilt and is the subject of the Director's Choice category.

This year some of us have had Joy Lamphere help us in the making of a medallion quilt and it was fun. Others of us have made medallion quilts for other reasons or inherited them.

It would be nice to share these with others in our quilting world and we have been invited to do so by the CFM. This is **NOT** a judged or juried show.

What's needed: - a quilt (with a 3" sleeve attached for hanging) - the story behind the quilt

Your quilt and story would need to be dropped off at CFM between Jul 1 - 17, 2021 on Tues, Thurs or Sat between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. The pick-up time would be Oct 2, 5 or 7, 2021 during the same times. A photo will be taken of you and your quilt when it is dropped off.

SEPTEMBER 13, 2021 "MONDAY" ANN SHAW LECTURE ON VISUALIZING QUILTS WITH LIGHTHOUSE QUILT GUILD

"This lecture presents an overview of my approach to designing quilts and how differing choices can influence the look of a quilt. A series of examples illustrate my design process, from creating a pattern to unusual fabric choices. I am happy to answer questions from the audience during my presentation." (1 hour)

Quilt Design Basics: Leaf (2 day) Leaves are a perennial favorite for quilt blocks among quilters – autumnal leaves, Christmas holly, hosta leaves and many others all make great quilt blocks or small quilts.

We will need a very strong commitment from at least 12 people to run the workshop. The cost will be \$50.00 plus the pattern fee of \$10.00. The workshop will be divided up into two sessions, each will be 90-120 minutes.
