SEPTEMBER 13, 2021 "MONDAY" ANN SHAW LECTURE ON VISUALIZING QUILTS WITH LIGHTHOUSE QUILT GUILD

"This lecture presents an overview of my approach to designing quilts and how differing choices can influence the look of a quilt. A series of examples illustrate my design process, from creating a pattern to unusual fabric choices. I am happy to answer questions from the audience during my presentation." (1 hour)

Quilt Design Basics: Leaf (2 day) Leaves are a perennial favorite for quilt blocks among quilters – autumnal leaves, Christmas holly, hosta leaves and many others all make great quilt blocks or small quilts.

We are considering her foliage workshop as that seems a good start and the most versatile. Please check out her description on her webpage. We will need a very strong commitment from at least 12 people to run the workshop. The cost will be \$50.00 plus the pattern fee of \$10.00. The workshop will be divided up into two sessions, each will be 90-120 minutes. 
