# **Bylaw Changes/Additions:**

The Committee given the task of revising/updating the Bylaws of the Patchers at the Lakeshore Quilt Guild consisted of Suzette Mattson, Deborah Taylor and Sue Webb. They met on July 8, 2022, and the following sections were updated/added (in bold, yellow, and italicized). Please read/review these changes carefully and a vote will be taken at the December 5, 2022, General meeting.

### 1. ARTICLE III BOARD Section 2 Number

- (Was) There shall be six (6) directors on the Board. Each Officer of the Corporation shall be a member of the Board of Directors. A director must be a member of the Corporation.
- (Revised) There shall be <u>seven (7)</u> directors on the Board. Each Officer of the Corporation shall be a member of the Board of Directors. A Director must be a member\_of the Corporation.
- 2. ARTICLE V OFFICERS Section 1 Number
  - (Was) The officers of the Corporation shall be elected by the membership at each annual meeting. The officers shall be a chairperson, co-chairperson, secretary, treasurer, assistant treasurer, and newsletter editor. Each officer so elected shall be a voting member of the Board. No person may hold two or more offices.
  - (Revised) The officers of the Corporation shall be elected by the membership at each annual meeting. The officers shall be: Chairperson(s), Co-Chairperson(s), Secretary, Treasurer, <u>Assistant Treasurer</u>, <u>Media</u>/Newsletter Editor <u>and</u>

    <u>Resources.</u> Each officer so elected shall be a voting member of the Board. No person may hold two or more <u>of these</u> offices
- 3. ARTICLE V OFFICERS Section 6 Secretary

(Was) The Secretary shall:

(a) keep minutes of all membership and board meetings.

(Revised) (a) keep minutes of all general meetings and all board meetings.

4. ARTICLE V OFFICERS Section 9 Newsletter Editor

(Was) Newsletter Editor

(Revised) *Media*/Newsletter Editor

5. ARTICLE V OFFICERS Section 10 Vacancies

(Was) Vacancies

(Revised) Resources (New)

The Resources person shall set up programs, classes, bus trips, retreats, vendors and any other special activities, with prior approval of the Board.

**6. (Was)** Nothing. (Moved from previous Vacancies Section above.)

(Revised) ARTICLE V OFFICERS Section 11 Vacancies

Vacancies in elected offices shall be filled in accordance with Article III, Section 6, above.


