New Upcoming BOM activities

***The Basket Medallion Quilt** -Complete and show your flimsy or finished quilt. There will be a choice of 4 patterns for the medallion to start. A \$2 fee covers printing to be paid at sign up. The following 3 months, a new pattern can be picked up at the resource table to complete your next 3 rounds. Scrappy or matching, the choice is yours. You can change or add to each round to make it your own & have creative fun!

***The Birds** will be a quirky raw edge applique and will be 9 BOMs . The first block & supply list will be available at sign up with a \$5 fee for printing. Members who love applique are willing to provide a class to anyone who would like to learn this technique. A sign-up list will be ready so we can arrange a date, time, and space for a class.

March 4-Laura Heine Collage Classes & Lecture by Certified Instructor Carrie Latesky March 3 & 4, 2024 PALS will sponsor Collage classes by West Michigan Certified Laura Heine Educator Carrie Latesky. Each day's class will use the Teeny Tiny #5 Pattern, which includes 3 designs: Tomato Pin Cushion, Dress Form and Featherweight Sewing Machine. Choose one design to create for class.

Class Fee is \$90 (Pattern is Included in Fee) Each person must have their own pattern. If you own this pattern already, Carrie will substitute with another Teeny Tiny Pattern. You must indicate which pattern substitution you want at registration so she can bring it to the class. Carrie also makes fabric kits specific to the designs. Kits are \$40 each - the background fabric is included. If you want a kit, it must be preordered and paid for at registration with the class fee. That total is \$130.

Classes will be held at Quilted Memories Inc, 9919 US HWY 31, Montague, Michigan. Class time is 9:30-4:00 each day. Doors open at 9 am. Please sign in first then finish preparation for class. You will need a bag lunch and beverage.

No sewing machine needed. You will need a Goddess Applique Pressing Sheet 17 x 24 or a Precision Fusing Mat 17 x 24 or larger, a small rotary cutter & mat (12x17), sharp scissors – Recommended: Karen K Buckley Blue Handled Perfect Scissors. Full Supply List will be given at Registration.

Quilted Memories will have Applique Fusing Mats, Karen K Buckley's Scissors and other supplies needed for this collage class for purchase before class. If you call owner Jill Twiss 231-893-0096 a few days ahead and she can have your selections ready.

- * Quilt must be 40" wide X 30" tall
- * Quilt must contain at least one dinosaur
- * Quilt must feature a favorite color


Quilt must have a design feature that breaks the border.

Remember that we do not have actual photos of dinosaurs, all images are imagined renderings from the fossils found. You can imagine YOUR favorite dinosaur in many different colors/textures!

Finished Size: 48 1/2" x 48 1/2"

THROW QUILT

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- One Print Layer Cake or 36 -10" print squares Shop Layer Cakes at: www.fatquartershop.com/layer-cakes
- 5/8 yard binding
- 3 ¼ yards backing

CUTTING


- Cut sixteen 10" squares into: 1 - 8 1/2" square - 16 total (Fabric A)
- Cut sixteen 10" squares into: 2 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 32 total (Fabric B)
- Cut four 10" squares into: 4 - 4 1/2" squares - 16 total (Fabric C)
- Cut binding fabric into: 6 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric D)


Layer Cake Loop **Quilt Pattern** Fat Quarter Shop Exclusive

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout. **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:**

Assemble Block.

Layer Cake Loop Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Layer Cake Loop


Quilt Pattern Fat Quarter Shop Exclusive

QUILT CENTER:

Assemble Quilt Center rotating every other block.

Press rows in opposite directions.

Quilt Center should measure 48 1/2" x 48 1/2".



FINISHING:

Piece the Fabric D strips end to end. Quilt and bind as desired.
